

Hoang's update on 'innovations in strategic delta planning'



Hoang attended **Geoscience conference 2018**, namely International Conference on Geology & Earth Science, as a poster presenter. In which, the presentation was about **"Political agenda setting for strategic delta planning in the Mekong delta – Converging or diverging agendas of policy actors and of the Mekong Delta Plan?"** She received a lot of significant comments that are valuable for her to improve her skills of doing a poster presentation next time. However, the study got positive remarks from international experts.

Hoang got offers of 2 grant sources for her next academic activities. One grant is for her attendance at **Adaptation Future 2018 that will be held in Cape Town – South Africa, from 17-21 June 2018, for her oral presentation on paper "Room for the River"**. The grant will cover: registration fee, accommodation for entire duration of the conference – 5 nights, meals and internal travel costs. Another grant has been offer to her participation at the In Situ Graduate School Delta Cities: rethinking practices of the urban, which will take place in Vietnam from 10-15 December 2018. The grant will cover: travel grant of 500 euros, registration fee, accommodation for entire duration of the event – 7 nights. Prof. David Biggs is one of the conveners of this event.

Hoang will attend in CSDS (conference on 25-26 June 2018 – Sustainable development Goals and Governance) as a **poster presenter**. The presentation will be particularly on **"Perception of the Vietnamese Mekong Delta's farmers towards Floating rice as a cultivation way to adapt to flood"**. The poster has been sent to CSDS for registration and has been accepted.

Hoang and her co-authors has submitted the article on "Political agenda setting for strategic delta planning in the Mekong delta – Converging or diverging agendas of policy actors and of the Mekong Delta Plan?" to the Special Issue of JEPM, manuscript ID CJEP-2018-0148. She is currently working on other publications on the role of innovations in addressing sustainability of water management in the Mekong Delta.
